A Day at the Zoo!

3rd Grade Special Education Ms. Brumleve's class



Introduction:

The Zippidy Zoo is hiring new employees! In this activity, you will choose one zoo animal to research. Once you know all about your animal, you will become the zookeeper for that animal and you will teach the class what you have to do to take care of it. You will also write a paragraph to go along with your presentation.

Task:

Your task is to pick a zoo animal. You can choose from this list:

Chimpanzee	Giraffe	Hippo	King Penguin	Red Panda		
Gorilla	Lion	Alligator	Black Lemur	Elephant		
(It is alread if more than one of you chooses the same animal)						

(It is okay if more than one of you chooses the same animal.)

Once you pick your animal, you need to do research on your animal. You will need to be able to answer the following questions:

- 1. What kind of habitat does your animal live in?
- 2. What does your animal eat?
- 3. What are some interesting facts about your animal? (List at least 3)

Process:

Step 1: We will watch a PowerPoint presentation in class to introduce the lesson.

Step 2: You will each be given the chance to choose the animal you want to research.

- **Step 3:** We will go to the computer lab to begin research.
- Step 4: You will have two days in the computer lab to finish your research. Each day we will spend 1 hour in the lab.
- Step 5: Once research is finished and you have answered all of the questions, we will go back to the classroom. We will spend one hour each day after our lab time to work on the following assignments.
- **Step 6:** In the classroom, you will each get a poster board and make a poster to present to the class. You may use the markers, crayons, colored pencils, construction paper, scissors, and glue kept in the art corner. On this poster you will need to draw your animal. Since you learned about its habitat and what it eats, you will need to put that information on your poster as well.
- Step 7: Now you have been hired as the zoo keeper for your animal and you need to give a presentation to your classmates. You will present your poster and describe what you learned from your research. You need to tell the class about your animal's habitat, food, and some facts.
- **Step 8:** After everyone presents their posters, you will all write a 5-10 sentence paragraph on what you learned while doing research.
